TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2019

1. The competition is directed to students of 1st and 2nd degree music schools.
2. The participants take part in single-step competition auditions in the following categories:
 - I a category** – soloists up to 8 years old – born up to 2011
– *programme length up to 3 min.*
 - I b category** – soloists up to 9 years old – born in 2010
– *programme length up to 5 min.*
 - I c category** -soloists up to 10 years old – born in 2009
– *programme length up to 5 min.*
 - I d category** –soloists up to 11 years old – born in 2008
– *programme length up to 8 min.*
 - I e category** - soloists up to 12 years old – born in 2007
– *programme length up to 10 min.*
 - II category** - soloists up to 13-14 years old – born in 2006, 2005
– *programme length up to 15 min.*
 - III category** – soloists up to 15-16 years old – born in 2004, 2003
– *programme length up to 15 min.*
 - IV category** – soloists up to 17-18 years old – born in 2002, 2001
– *programme length up to 20 min.*
 - V category** soloists up to 19 years old – born in 2000 and earlier
– *programme length up to 20 min.*
 - VI category** - accordion ensembles (including only accordions)
(from a duo to an orchestra) – pupils of primary music schools, age of participants up to 15 years
– *programme length up to 15 min.*

3. Program presentation:
 - a) Category I a – a free choice programme,
 - b) Category I b – **obligatory one piece by a composer from the country of the audition participant - Stanisław Moniuszko (appendage no 1 for Rules of IIIrd International Accordion Competitions) the rest a free choice programme,**
 - c) Category I c - **obligatory one piece by a composer from the country of the audition participant - Stanisław Moniuszko (appendage no 1 for Rules of IIIrd International Accordion Competitions) the rest a free choice programme,**
 - d) Category I d - **obligatory one piece by a composer from the country of the audition participant - Stanisław Moniuszko (appendage no 1 for Rules of IIIrd International Accordion Competitions) the rest a free choice programme,**
 - e) Category I e, II, III, IV, V – a free choice programme.
4. **It will not be possible to change the repertoire after accepting the application.**
5. The competition auditions will be held at a Concert hall name of Kazimierz Serocki and at second Concert hall name of Irena Santor in Frederic Chopin Primary Music School in Solec Kujawski, Poland, 23 Stycznia 13 Street.
6. Ocasional Concert`s will be held at a Concert hall in centre of Culture in Solec Kujawski, Poland, gen. Stefana Roweckiego „Grota” 1 Street.
7. The competition participants are obliged to provide 3 copies (photocopies) of music sheets for the presented programme. **Lack of music sheets for the presented programme causes disqualification of the participant.**
8. The participants' programme will be judged by an international competition Jury appointed by the Organiser, according to the scale of 1 to 25 points. Participants getting:
 - from 23 points 1st prize,
 - from 22 points 2nd prize,
 - from 21 points 3rd prize,
 - from 20 points honorable mention.Jury decisions are final.
9. The order will be decided by Organisers by drawing of the lots.
10. The Competition winners will receive diplomas of winners and awards; the awards will be assigned by the Jury.
11. All Competition participants will receive diplomas confirming their participation.
12. Completed application with a proof of payment and consent to the processing of personal data should be sent to the **ORGANISER OFFICE** (at: konkursy@psm.soleckujawski.pl) in title **IIIrd International Accordion Competition** by April 19th, 2019.

15. Participant`s applications will be kept by co-organizer Frederic Chopin Primary Music School. Applications of participants who do not take part in the competition will be destroyed.

17. Winners in each category will play on the laureate`s concert.
18. The Organiser and co-organiser (Frederic Chopin Primary Music School in Solec Kujawski) have the right to distribute audiovisual recordings.
